SHELL FALLS

120-foot waterfall with a viewing platform and interpretive center. A perfect first stop.

Short trails near Shell Falls or longer hikes in the surrounding forest.

Climb into the Bighorns for cool air, alpine views, and a stop at the famous (and quirky)



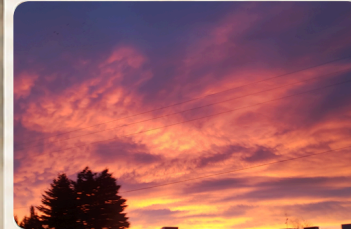
STAY: OVERNIGHT IN THE MOUNTAINS
